Conservative Victory over Jim Evison event application



Following on from our quick action last week to alert local residents, I'm pleased to let you know that common sense has prevailed, and the application for the event on the Jim Evison playing field has been withdrawn!

That is great news for those of us who campaigned against it, whether that is me as the local MP, my Conservative colleagues Barry Estill and Hannan Sarwar, who are standing in this ward at the local elections in May, or the residents who raised their concerns to the Council or myself.

'Thank you for reacting so quickly when I contacted you. I am delighted that the application has been withdrawn, I am very grateful for your support' -Michael

This was never about whether there should be a two-day event in Wilmslow attracting 25,000 a day but about whether the Jim Evison playing field was the right venue for such a large-scale event. The people who told me their concern had a number of issues, and I suspect some of those, particularly around parking, road safety, and disruption to local residents may have proved too challenging to resolve given the scale of the event.

I had planned to attend the licencing hearing on behalf of residents but the withdrawal means that won't be necessary. I was particularly concerned that local residents hadn't known about the application, and that is why we contacted them to ensure their views were paramount in the decision making process.

As your local MP, I am happy to help when I can on any local issue - as are Barry and Hannan. Please get in touch if you ever think we can help with anything at all.
